# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section 47 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes, in relation to the possession of liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-seven of chapter twenty-nine of 2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the 3 word "or" in the last line of said section, and inserting in 4 place thereof the word 'and,' and said section is further 5 amended by adding after the word "days" the following: 6 'And in default of payment, sixty days additional,' so that 7 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 47. No person shall deposit or have in his posses-9 sion intoxicating liquors with intent to sell the same in the

10 State in violation of law, or with intent that the same shall 11 be so sold by any person, or to aid or assist any person in 12 such sale. Whoever violates this section shall be fined one 13 hundred dollars and costs and be imprisoned sixty days, and 14 in default of payment, sixty days additional.'
