### STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relating to scaling logs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The commission appointed by the Governor un-

2 der the authority of an order of the last Legislature, of date

3 of March 14, 1907, is hereby continued in office with power

4 to recommend some appropriate standard cubic rule and the

5 application or use thereof. Their report shall be made on or

6 before September first, 1909, to the Governor, who shall

7 transmit the same to the next Legislature for its action there-

8 on. Their bills for time actually employed, at no more than

9 five dollars per day and actual expenses shall be approved by

10 the Governor and Council and be paid out of any moneys in

11 the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
