STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 1 of Chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes in regard to malicious mischiefs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1 of chapter 128 of the Revised Statutes is hereby 2 amended by inserting after the word "animal" in the sec-3 ond line thereof the words 'or dog,' so that said section as 4 amended shall read as follows:

'Section I. Whoever wilfully or maliciously kills, wounds, 6 maims, disfigures or poisons any domestic animal, or dog, 7 or exposes any poisonous substance with intent that the life 8 of such animal should be destroyed thereby, shall be pun-9 ished by imprisonment for not more than four years, or by 10 fine not exceeding five hundred dollars.' •
