STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to authorize the York Light and Heat Company to
acquire additional properties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The York Light and Heat Company is hereby
2 authorized to purchase and acquire, and to own and hold the
3 stock, plants, property and franchises of the Agamenticus
4 Light and Power Company, the Agamenticus Electric Light
5 Company, the Kennebunk Electric Light Company, and the
6 Wells Electric Light and Power Company, and each of said
7 companies is hereby authorized to sell and convey its said
8 property, plant and franchise, and upon acquiring the same
9 said York Light and Heat Company shall exercise and enjoy

10 throughout the territory covered by the franchise of such
11 other company or companies, all the rights, powers and
12 privileges thereof, and shall be subject to all duties and re-
13 strictions thereon imposed.

Sect. 2. The organization and charter of the Agamenticus
2 Electric Light Company, a corporation organized under the
3 general law, and of the Wells Electric Light and Power
4 Company are each hereby ratified and confirmed, and the
5 mortgage bond issues made by said companies, and by said
6 Kennebunk Electric Light Company, are hereby approved
7 and confirmed, and the guaranty by said York Light and
8 Heat Company of the bonds and interest coupons, issued or
9 to be issued by each of said companies, is hereby author-
10 ized and approved.

Sect. 3. The provisions of this act shall in no way affect
2 or impair any existing contract between any persons, cor-
3 poration or municipality and any of the above specified
4 corporations, and said York Light and Heat Company upon
5 acquiring the property, rights and franchises of any such
6 corporation, shall assume and perform its contracts and
7 obligations.
