STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to change the method of electing Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 34 of Chapter 15 of the Revised Stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended by adding after the word "commit-
- 3 tee" in the sixth line of said section the words 'or if a major-
- 4 ity of the voters present shall so direct the superintendent of
- 5 schools shall be elected at the annual town meeting', so that
- 6 said section when amended shall read as follows:
- 'Sect. 34. The management of schools and the custody
- 8 and care, including repairs and insurance on school build-
- 9 ings, of all school property in every town, shall devolve upon
- 10 the superintending school committee which shall annually,

and as often as a vacancy shall occur, elect a superintendent of schools who shall not be a member of the committee, or if a majority of the voters present so direct, the superingular tendent of schools shall be elected at the annual town meeting. This section shall not apply to cities, nor to towns authorized by special laws to employ or choose superintendents in a manner otherwise than as herein provided.
