STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND ELEVEN.

AN ACT to abolish the state agency for sale of intoxicating
liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Sections fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, seventeen,
2 eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-
3 three, twenty-four and twenty-five of Chapter twenty-nine of
4 the Revised Statutes and all acts and parts of acts additional
5 thereto and amendatory thereof are hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. Chapter two hundred and fifty-two of the Public
2 Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby repealed.
