STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Waldo County General Hospital,

Belfast.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the

- 2 sum of one thousand dollars to be paid to the Waldo County
- 3 General Hospital, Belfast, for the year nineteen hundred
- 4 and thirteen, and one thousand dollars for the year nine-
- 5 teen hundred and fourteen, for maintenance.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Waldo County General Hospital, as per estimates filed with the State Auditor, requires for running expenses, repairs and interest on mortgage, for the year 1913, the sum of \$6,930; for 1914 for running expenses, interest and repairs, and for building a stable, the sum of \$7,330, making a total for the two years, \$14,260, and an appropriation of \$2000 for each of these years, together with receipts from patients, investments and subscriptions, would enable the hospital to carry on its work with greater economy, and probably to reduce its ward rates, which are now \$1.50 per day.

This institution is doing a great deal of charitable work, and no one is turned from its doors because of lack of means to pay for treatment.

For the years 1911 and 1912, an appropriation of \$1000 per year was made, but in view of the greater demands upon its resources, due to the extension of its work, it is believed that the appropriation asked for is none too large.
