STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Bar Harbor Medical and Surgical Hospital, located at Bar Harbor, Maine.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of two thousand dollars to be paid to the Bar Harbor 3 Medical and Surgical Hospital toward the running expenses 4 of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and thir-5 teen, and two thousand dollars toward the running expenses 6 of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and four-7 teen.

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STATEMENT OF FACTS. BAR HARBOR HOSPITAL.

The thirteenth year of active service of the hospital has just been completed. Two hundred and sixteen patients have been received and treated; one hundred and forty-eight of these have been treated in the surgical wards; one hundred and fifteen cured; ten improved; nine have not improved; eight are now in the hospital, and six have died. Fifty-nine patients have been treated in the medical wards; thirty-five of them cured; five improved; three not improved; eight are now in the hospital, and eight have died. There were nine other cases in the hospital including obstetrical, births and patients received for examination. Five free beds in the hospital have been occupied by sixty-one patients during the year, aggregating a total of seven hundred and forty-six days. Three of these free beds are endowed and two are maintained by the hospital.
