STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and twenty of the
Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-
nine relating to the establishment of a Municipal Court in
the town of East Livermore.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Amend section 1 of said chapter one hundred
2 and twenty of the Private and Special Laws of 1899 by in-
3 serting after the word "judge" in the fourth line of said
4 section the words 'who shall be a member of the bar in
5 Androscoggin county, and' so that said section as amended
6 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. A municipal court is hereby established in

8 and for the towns of Livermore, East Livermore and Leeds,
9 in the county of Androscoggin, to be denominated the
10 Livermore Falls municipal court; said court shall consist
11 of one judge, who shall be a member of the bar in Andros-
12 coggin county, and who shall reside during his continuance
13 in said office, in said town of Livermore, East Livermore
14 or Leeds, and who shall be appointed, qualified and hold his
15 office as provided in the constitution, and who shall be, ex-
16 officio, a justice of the peace and of the quorum, and have
17 and exercise a concurrent authority and jurisdiction with
18 trial justices over all matters and things by law within their
19 jurisdiction, and such authority and jurisdiction additional
20 thereto as is conferred upon him by this act.'

And said chapter is further amended by striking out all
22 of section thirteen and inserting in place thereof the
23 following:

All fees, civil and criminal, shall inure to the county of
25 Androscoggin and shall be paid over to the treasurer of
26 said county by said judge on the first day of each month.
27 The judge of said court shall receive an annual salary of
28 four hundred dollars in full for all services payable quar-
29 terly on the first days of April, July, October and January
30 from the treasury of Androscoggin county.'

And said chapter is further amended by striking out all of
32 section fourteen and inserting in place thereof the follow-
33 ing:

'All expenses of said court, including court room, blank

35 books of record, docket and blanks necessary for the use
36 of said court, shall be paid from the treasury of the county
37 of Androscoggin on vouchers approved by the county
38 commissioners of said county and said county commis-
39 sioners shall audit and approve all accounts of said judge
40 annually the last of December for the year ending with said
41 month.'
