STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Stenographer of the Presiding and Recording Officers of the House of Representatives.

Resolved, in accordance with Order of the House, passed 2 January 1, 1913, authorizing the Clerk of the House to 3 procure a stenographer during the Legislative session of 4 the Seventy-sixth Legislature to assist the Presiding and 5 Recording Officers of the House, that the sum of four hun- 6 dred and fifty dollars be and hereby is appropriated to be 7 paid to Nita L. Goodell of Augusta, for services being ren- 8 dered in the preparation of the journal of the House and to 9 be rendered in the preparation of the index of said journal, 10 being the same amount that was appropriated for such pur- 11 pose in nineteen hundred and eleven.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The House on January 1st, 1913, passed the following order:

“Ordered, that the Clerk of the House be authorized to procure the services of a stenographer to assist the Presiding and Recording Officers of the House during the present session.”

This resolve is drawn to pay for stenographer's services in pursuance of the above order, and is the same amount appropriated for the same purpose at the last session of the Legislature.
