STATEMENT OF FACTS ACCOMPANYING RESOLVE
IN FAVOR OF WARREN B. CLARK.

This resolve and one introduced at the same time in favor of John Metcalf, are to cover the legal expenses of the contestants incurred by reason of the contest before the Committee on Elections to determine the question of who was entitled to the seat in this House representing the seventh legislative class from Somerset county.
