STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT defining Intoxicating Liquors within the meaning of the Constitution, and providing for the regulation of the sale of certain liquors containing alcohol.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. Intoxicating liquors within the meaning of 2 amendment 5 of the Constitution of Maine are hereby de-3 fined to be any liquors containing over 8% of alcohol.

Sect. 2. Any city, town or organized plantation may at 2 its annual meeting determine whether liquors containing 3 8% or less of alcohol shall be sold within its limits and may 4 establish the conditions of their sale or empower its munici-5 pal officers so to do.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
