STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Fort William Henry in the Town of Bristol.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated for the 2 care and maintenance of the memorial tower erected by the 3 state at Fort William Henry and for such other purposes 4 connected with the care and enlargement of the reservation 5 and state property thereunto appertaining as may, in the 6 judgment of the agents having the care thereof, be neces-7 sary and for the public interest, the sum of five hundred 8 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and five 9 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and four-10 teen.
