#### STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to provide for a close time on Bull Moose.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall, within four years from Octo-2 ber fifteenth, in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and 3 thirteen, hunt, chase, catch, kill or have in possession any 4 bull moose or part thereof.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, 3 or by imprisonment not exceeding four months, for each

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4 bull moose taken, caught, killed or had in possession in vio-5 lation of any provision of this act. Whoever has any part 6 of a bull moose in possession in violation of this act shall 7 be subject to the same penalty.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.

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
