STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to set off from the town of Mason certain lots and
annex them to the town of Bethel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All that part of what was formerly Fryeburg
2 Academy Grant, in the county of Oxford, which was an-
3 nexed to the town of Mason by chapter 199, Private and
4 Special Laws of 1911, of the State of Maine, and which
5 lies easterly of the lot line dividing lots four and five in
6 ranges four, five, six, seven and eight as formerly lotted in
7 said grant, together with the inhabitants thereof, is hereby
8 set off from said town of Mason and annexed to the town of
9 Bethel.
