STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize a re-levy of assessment for sewer or any
other public improvements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. When by reason of no-conformity to any law
2 or ordinance or by reason of any omission in formality or
3 regularity, any special tax or assessment hereafter levied is
4 invalid, or is adjudged illegal, or in case of deficiencies, the
5 board of officers assessing the same shall have the power to
6 correct the same by resolution or ordinance and may re-
7 assess or re-levy the same as also an amount to make up
8 past deficiencies with the same force and effect as if done

9 at the proper time in the proper amount and in the manner
10 provided by law, or by the resolution or ordinance relating
11 thereto.
