STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the relief of poor debtors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 47 of Chapter 114 of the Revised Stat-2 utes is hereby amended by striking out all after the word 3 "officer" in the third line, viz.:

"And besides the other fees, he shall pay the jailer's fees 5 before he can be discharged." So that the section as amend-6 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 47. A debtor committed on execution may disclose 8 thereon at the jail, in the manner and on the notice afore-9 said, which may be served by the jailer or other officer.'
