RESOLVE, authorizing the State Land Agent to convey to Charles L. Babson, of Sargentville, the State's interest in Two Bush Island and Black Ledges in East Penobscot Bay.

---

*Resolved:* That the State Land Agent, be and hereby is  
2 authorized to convey the State's right, title and interest in  
3 and to Two Bush Island and Black Ledges, situated in East  
4 Penobscot Bay, to Charles L. Babson, of Sargentville. The  
5 purchase price shall be what the Land Agent deems just and  
6 equitable.

Two Bush Island is further described as lying about two  
8 miles southwest from Pumpkin Island Lighthouse station.  
9 Black ledges are a group of small ledges about two miles  
10 northwesterly from Two Bush Island and southwesterly  
11 from Pond Island.
