STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to exempt certain School Property from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Houses and land owned by or held in trust for
2 classes, clubs, or societies of students pursuing studies in
3 literary or scientific institutions and actually occupied by
4 such students shall be exempt from taxation.
