STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT for the better protection of blueberry lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Whoever enters upon the land of another, used

- 2 for the production of blueberries for commercial purposes,
- 3 and severs and carries away therefrom blueberries, shall be
- 4 deemed guilty of larceny and shall be punished accordingly.
