AN ACT for the better protection of blueberry lands.

---

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever enters upon the land of another, used  
2 for the production of blueberries for commercial purposes,  
3 and severs and carries away therefrom blueberries, shall be  
4 deemed guilty of larceny and shall be punished accordingly.
