STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE for extra pay to the Maine Volunteers in the War
with Spain.

Resolved, That the sums of sixty-six dollars for the year
2 nineteen hundred thirteen and sixty-six dollars for the year
3 nineteen hundred fourteen, be and are hereby appropriated
4 for extra pay for the Maine volunteers in war with Spain.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The above is for payment of bounty to the Maine Volunteers in War with Spain of which six hundred and eighty-two dollars is still unpaid. It has been customary to appropriate sixty-six dollars for each year to cover any claims that may be presented.
