STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE authorizing the Land Agent to convey Lower Mark
Island in Sheepscot Bay.

Resolved, That the land agent of the state of Maine be and
2 is hereby authorized to convey to W. G. Love of Southport,
3 Lincoln county, Maine, the island known as Lower Mark
4 island, lying westerly of the southerly end of Southport and
5 estimated to contain about a quarter of an acre of soil; the
6 consideration for said island shall be for a nominal sum.
