STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 55 of the Private and Special Laws of Maine for the year 1903, as amended by Chapter 12 of the Private and Special Laws for the year 1909 relating to Squirrel Island Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That section 5 of chapter 55 of the Private and Special Laws of Maine for 1903, as amended by chapter 12 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909, be and the same is hereby amended by striking out the words "seventy-five" and inserting the word 'fifty,' so that the section as amended shall read:

‘Sect. 5. The town of Southport shall annually pay over
8 to the treasurer of said corporation out of the taxes col-
9 lected from the inhabitants and estates on Squirrel Island,
10 a sum equal to fifty per centum of all the town taxes, ex-
11 clusive of the state and county tax collected from said in-
12 habitants and estates.’
