IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize Calais Street Railway to sell Electricity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The charter of the Calais Street Railway, chapter 519, 2 Acts of 1893, approved March 17, 1893, is hereby amended 3 by adding the following paragraph to section one, to wit:

‘Said company is authorized to generate, buy and sell elec- 5 tricity for power, heat and all commercial, manufacturing 6 and domestic uses from which it is not excluded by the gen- 7 eral laws of Maine; and it may acquire the property and 8 franchise of any existing light company and thereafter carry 9 on that business; and for any or all said purposes it may 10 erect and maintain poles and wires and transmit electricity 11 along the same in the manner provided by law.’
