STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of the County of York to raise and expend a certain sum of money on the Court House and county offices connected therewith.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The county commissioners of the county of
2 York are hereby authorized and directed to raise by loan a
3 sum of money not exceeding twenty thousand dollars, and
4 to issue notes or bonds therefor on such terms, times and
5 rates as may by them be deemed best and advantageous, and
6 they are hereby authorized and directed to make additions,

7 improvements and alterations in and upon the court house
8 and county offices connected therewith, situated in the town
9 of Alfred, and to do and perform all and singular as is fully
10 set forth in Section XI of Chapter LXXX of the Revised
11 Statutes of Maine of 1903 and of Chapter 164 of the Public
12 Laws of 1907.
