STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, making an appropriation for the purpose of obtaining information in regard to wild lands for the purposes of Taxation.

Resolved: That the sum of five thousand dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and
3 thirteen and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and
4 fourteen, to be expended by the board of state assessors un-
5 der the direction of the governor and council, for the pur-
6 pose of employing a competent person or persons whose duty
7 it shall be to assist said board in verifying and perfecting,
8 so far as practicable, a proper description of each parcel or

9 tract of wild land, and the individual or corporate ownership
10 thereof in townships not incorporated, in order that such
11 lands may be properly described for taxation purposes, and
12 for incorporating such descriptions in deeds when lands are
13 sold for taxes; also for the employment of competent per-
14 son or persons to assist said board of state assessors in mak-
15 ing special exploration of wild land townships to ascertain
16 for taxation purposes their just and fair value. Said board
17 in their regular report shall incorporate a report of the work
18 done under this resolve and a summarized statement of their
19 expenditures.
