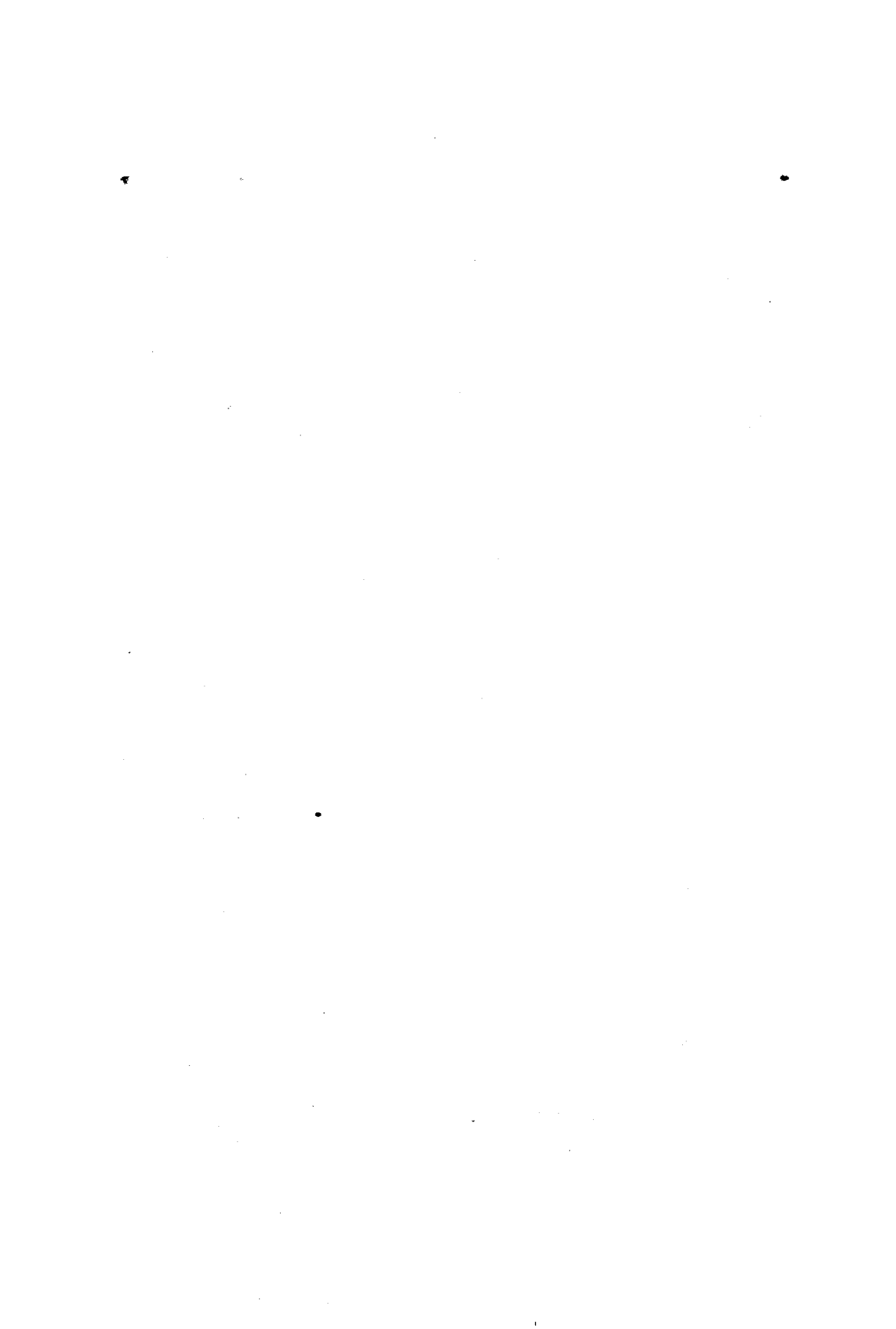

STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of repairing the bridge across the Kennebec River between the Plantations of West Forks and The Forks.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) to aid in the repair of
3 the bridge across the Kennebec river between the planta-
4 tions of West Forks and The Forks, in Somerset county,
5 provided the county of Somerset appropriates the sum of
6 six hundred dollars (\$600) for the same purpose; both
7 sums to be expended by the county commissioners of Som-
8 erset county under the supervision of the State Highway
9 Department.



STATEMENT OF FACT.

This bridge is on the direct road from Maine to Canada. It is a covered, wooden bridge and the upper side has settled about ten inches. It is reported to be in an unsafe condition by the County Commissioners of Somerset county and Engineer E. E. Greenwood of Skowhegan. The plantations of The Forks and West Forks are in debt to the limit. If the bridge can be repaired the coming summer, at this small expense of about twelve hundred dollars (\$1200) it will be all right for several years without rebuilding.
