STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to regulate the rates to be charged to consumers of gas by the Municipal Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Whenever the Portland Gas Light Company 2 shall make any reduction in the maximum rate per one thou-3 sand cubic feet to be charged to the consumers of gas, from 4 the rate in force on January first, nineteen hundred thir-5 teen, the Municipal Light and Power Company shall make 6 an equal reduction in the price per one thousand cubic feet 7 to be charged to the consumers of gas within the territory 8 served by said company, and in case of successive reductions 9 made by the Portland Gas Light Company reductions of 10 equal amount shall be made by the said Municipal Light and 11 Power Company.

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
