STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the election of Assessors for the City of
Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The assessors for the City of Portland shall
2 hereafter be elected by the inhabitants thereof, voting in
3 their respective wards. One assessor shall be elected on the
4 first Monday in December in each year on the same ballot
5 as the mayor, by a plurality of the votes given; and shall
6 hold his office for three years from the second Monday in
7 December, and until some other person shall be elected and
8 qualified in his place.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent herewith,
2 are hereby repealed.
