AN ACT to prohibit lobster pot fishing in York River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for
2 lobsters with a lobster pot in York river for the period of
3 four years.

Sect. 2. Any person taking shell fish contrary to the pro-
2 visions of this act, shall be punished for each offense by a
3 fine not exceeding ten dollars, or by imprisonment not ex-
4 ceeding thirty days, or by both.
