STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT additional to Chapter 181 of the Laws of 1911, entitled "An Act to establish in Cumberland County a County Farm."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county commissioners of the county of Cumberland 2 are hereby authorized to borrow a sum of money not ex3 ceeding twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), to be used
4 for the erection of buildings on Cumberland county farm,
5 and for the purchase of furnishings for said buildings, and
6 for the purchase of stock, tools and implements necessary

7 for the proper conduct and management of said county

8 farm, and to issue interest bearing bonds of said county of o Cumberland for that purpose.

Said bonds shall be signed by the treasurer of the county, 11 countersigned by the county commissioners, and attested 12 under the seal of the county by the clerk of courts for said 13 county.
