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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT additional to chapter twenty-eight of the Revised  
Statutes for the Prevention of False Fire Alarms.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever knowingly and wilfully gives or  
2 causes to be given a false alarm of fire in any city, town  
3 or village maintaining an organized fire department shall  
4 upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more  
5 than fifty dollars and if such false alarm shall be given  
6 between the hours of seven o'clock in the evening and four  
7 o'clock in the morning he shall be punished by said fine

8 and in addition thereto shall be imprisoned in the county  
9 jail for not less than ten nor more than sixty days.

Sect. 2. Judges of police and municipal courts shall have  
2 jurisdiction of all violations of this act within their counties.
