STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to Close Androscoggin lake situated in Wayne, Kennebec county, and in Leeds, Androscoggin county, to all ice fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish through the ice at
2 any season of the year in Androscoggin lake, which is locat-
3 ed partly in the town of Wayne, county of Kennebec, and
4 partly in the town of Leeds, county of Androscoggin.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall
2 be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the general

3 law of the State for the illegal fishing, taking, catching, kill-
4 ing or having in possession trout or landlock salmon.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal, po-
2 lice and trial justices within their respective counties shall
3 have, upon complaint, original and concurrent jurisdiction
4 with the supreme judicial and superiors courts, and all fines,
5 forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this act
6 shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving them to the
7 State Treasurer.
