STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Peter Harmon of Thorndike.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated to be paid to Peter Harmon of
3 Thorndike for the expense incurred by him in the 77th
4 legislature in contesting the seat of James J. Clement of
5 Montville in the House of Representatives and that the same
6 be appropriated and paid as a part of the legislative expenses
7 of the state legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

James J. Clement was duly returned by the governor and council as entitled to a seat in the 77th legislature. Notice of contest was filed by Peter Harmon of Thorndike, and the case heard by the House Committee on Elections was determined that said claimant was entitled to his seat by a majority of two votes. The above expenses were incurred by said Harmon in presenting his case before the committee.
