IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to create a Commission to act in conjunction with
the State Armory Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Inspector General and Charles H. Osgood of Lewiston
2 are hereby created a commission with power to act in con-
3 junction with the State Armory Commission to determine
4 the feasibility of erecting armories at Lewiston and in other
5 parts of the State at the expense of the State; to inquire in-
6 to the probable cost of the same; to inspect such plans as
7 may be submitted to them in connection therewith and to
8 gather such information as may be obtained, and report the
9 results of their investigations to the next legislature.
