STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 206 of the Public Laws of 1913, relating to the Protection of Foxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall at any time between the first
2 day of March and the first day of November following of
3 each year dig out, molest or destroy in any way any fox
4 den or fox dens, or remove or cause to be removed there-
5 from any fox or foxes except those enclosed in private fox
6 ranches.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 pay a fine of ten dollars and costs for each offense.
