STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to ice fishing in Passadumkeag River, sometimes called Passadumkeag Stream, in the county of Penobscot and in the county of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish
2 on or through the ice at any time in Passadumkeag river,
3 sometimes called Passadumkeag stream, in the county of
4 Penobscot and in the county of Hancock.

No person shall have in possession at any time any kind
6 of fish taken in violation of any provision of this act.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine
8 of not less than ten nor more than thirty dollars and costs
9 for each offense; and in addition thereto one dollar for each
10 fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation
11 of any provision of this act.
