STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of the Town of Merrill.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred and seventy-four 2 dollars and forty cents (\$474.40) be and hereby is appro-3 priated to be paid to the Town of Merrill, the same being 4 the amount due said town as interest due from the State to 5 said town upon its school fund after its organization.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Town of Merrill at the time of its organization in 1911 had a school fund amounting to \$4,744.00. After the said town was organized the state treasurer paid to said town the interest up to January I, 1912, from January I, 1912, until August I, 1913, the state paid the principal sum to said town, but did not pay the interest accrued from said January I, 1912, to August I, 1913, amounting to \$474.40, which said town is entitled by law.
