**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN**

**AN ACT Providing for Pensions to Employees of the City of
Bangor.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. To any employee of the City of Bangor who
2 has rendered the city faithful service for a period of thirty
3 or more years, and has become incapacitated for further
4 useful service, there may be allowed and paid, upon the re-
5 tirement of such employee, a pension of twenty-five dollars
6 per month, payable semi-monthly, upon proof of such in-
7 capacity satisfactory to the City Council; and the City Coun-
8 cil may revoke such pension or pensions so granted at
9 any time by majority vote thereof.

Sect. 2. The City Council of the City of Bangor is authorized hereby to provide by proper appropriation, the money necessary for the payment of the pensions allowed under the provisions of this act.

Sect. 3. This act shall not apply to school teachers in the employ of the city, for whom provisions are made by the state for pensions to be paid by the state, nor to the policemen for whom pension is provided by law.
