STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section six of Chapter forty-four of the Revised Statutes, Providing a Penalty for Neglect of Duty by Local Sealers of Weights and Measures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section six of chapter forty-four of the revised statutes 2 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section preced- 3 ing the words "shall receive" in the third line thereof, and 4 by inserting in place thereof the following words, 'the per- 5 son so appointed', and by adding to said section the follow- 6 ing words: 'For every neglect of any duty prescribed by 7 this chapter he shall forfeit ten dollars to be recovered as 8 provided in section two of chapter forty-four of the revised 9 statutes as amended by section three of chapter one hundred

10 and sixteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred and thir-
11 teen,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

 'Sect. 6. The person appointed shall receive the standards
13 and seal from the treasurer, giving a receipt therefor, de-
14 scribing them and their condition, and therein engaging to
15 re-deliver them at the expiration of his office in like good
16 order; and he shall be accountable for their due preserva-
17 tion while in his possession. For every neglect of any duty
18 prescribed by this chapter he shall forfeit ten dollars to be
19 recovered as provided in section two of chapter forty-four
20 of the revised statutes, as amended by section three of chap-
21 ter one hundred and sixteen of the public laws of nineteen
22 hundred and thirteen.'
