STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in repairing a bridge across the
Piscataquis river in the town of Howland.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum
2 of three hundred dollars (\$300) to aid in painting and re-
3 planking a bridge across the Piscataquis river in the town
4 of Howland, provided that there be appropriated by said
5 town of Howland the sum of three hundred dollars for the
6 same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervi-
7 sion of the State Highway Commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is on the main thoroughfare, north and south, leading up and down the Penobscot valley and west side of the river, and the most of the travel is travel that originates outside the town of Howland. The State has several times in the past granted aid in the maintenance of this structure and an examination made by one of the engineers in the employ of the State Highway Commission in January, 1915, reveals the fact that the above repairs will be needed on this bridge during the next two years.
