STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in repairing Seboeis Bridge in the Town of Howland.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) to aid in repainting and 3 replanking the Seboeis bridge in the town of Howland, pro-4 vided there be appropriated by said town of Howland the 5 sum of two hundred dollars for the same purpose; both 6 sums to be expended under the supervision of the state high-7 way commission.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is on the main thoroughfare leading up the Piscataquis valley, which is the outlet for the towns of Seboeis, Maxfield and Milo, and as the most of the traffic crossing the bridge is not local traffic the state has heretofore granted aid in its maintenance.

An examination of this structure made by one of the engineers of the state highway commission, in January, revealed the fact that these repairs were necessary for the year 1915.
