STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of aid in repairing Mill Cove Bridge in the town of Robbinston.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to aid in repairing the 3 Mill Cove bridge, so-called, in the town of Robbinston, 4 Washington county, provided that there be appropriated by 5 said town of Robbinston, the sum of five hundred dollars 6 (\$500) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended 7 under the supervision of the State Highway Commission.

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STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The bridge for which this appropriation is asked is situated in the town of Robbinston on the direct road between Calais and Eastport. It crosses an arm of Passamaquoddy Bay, known as Mill Cove. It is exposed to the action of tide water and has been destroyed several times. The bridge is now in a dangerous condition as the result of severe storms in the year 1914. This appropriation is asked for the purpose of aiding the town in putting the bridge in a safe condition.
