STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in Aid of Navigation of Sebec Lake.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of one hundred dollars (\$100) for the placing of buoys,
3 and maintenance of lights and buoys in Sebec lake for the
4 year nineteen hundred fifteen; and the sum of one hundred
5 dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and
6 the maintenance of lights and buoys in said lake for the
7 year nineteen hundred sixteen. All said money shall be
8 expended under the direction of the state steamboat in-
9 spectors, and any part of the money hereby appropriated
10 which shall be unexpended at the end of the year nineteen
11 hundred sixteen shall revert to the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

For several years past the same amounts have been appropriated and used for the purposes set forth in said resolve. It is necessary as there are twelve steamboats and about seventy motor boats plying on said lake, and their navigation must be aided by the placing of new buoys and the maintenance of buoys and lights already placed.
