IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT relating to Scaling Round Timber and Marking the
Contents on same.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Any person measuring round timber the quantity of which
2 is estimated by the thousand shall scale the same with the
3 so called 5 line Holland Rule and mark upon each log sur-
4 veved by him the contents thereof, unless otherwise agreed
5 by the parties contracting.
