# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT To amend Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes as amended by Chapter 206 of the Public Laws of 1913, relating to fishing in the pool at Upper Dam and in the river from said pool to Lake Mollychunkamunk, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of section two of Chapter thirty-two of the revised 2 statutes as amended by Chapter two hundred and six of the 3 public laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, as prohibits 4 fishing in the ordinary way of angling with artificial flies, or 5 fly fishing, in the pool at Upper Dam and in the river run-6 ning from said pool to Lake Mollychunkamunk, in the 7 county of Oxford, from September fifteenth to September 8 thirtieth of each year, both days inclusive, is hereby repealed.
