STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to amend section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen, relating to fishing in Rapid River between Lower Richardson lake and Umbagog lake, and in Pond in the River, in the county of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. So much of section two of chapter thirty-two
2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred
3 and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thirteen,
4 as prohibits fishing in the ordinary way of angling with arti-

5 ficial flies, or fly fishing, in Rapid river, from Lower Rich-6 ardson Lake to Umbagog Lake, between September fifteenth 7 and September thirtieth of each year, both days inclusive, 8 is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of 2 the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred 3 and six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and thir-4 teen, as prohibits bait fishing in Pond in the River, in said 5 county of Oxford, between September fifteenth and Septem-6 ber thirtieth of each year, both days inclusive, is hereby 7 repealed.
