IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT To Amend Chapter 121 of the Private Laws of 1911, Relating to Board of Overseers of the Poor of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Is hereby amended by striking out the word
2 "ten" in the second line and inserting in place thereof, the
3 word 'nine' and inserting after the word "and" and before
4 the word, "the" in the second line the words 'in addition
5 thereto: also inserting after the word "Ex Officio" in the
6 fourth line, 'but shall have no vote except in case of a tie,'
7 so that section as amended shall read as follows:

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The Overseers of the Poor and Workhouse of the City of 9 Portland shall consist of nine persons and in addition there-10 to, the Chairman of the Board of Aldermen of the said city 11 shall be Chairman of the Overseers of the Poor and Work-12 house, Ex-Officio but shall have no vote except in case of a 13 tie.'

Sect. 2. Amend Section 2 of said Chapter by striking 2 out in the first line the words "the other nine persons of 3 the," and inserting thereof, the words 'board of' so that 4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'The Board of Overseers of the Poor and Workhouse shall 6 be elected at the first election of subordinate officers in Port-7 land on the second Monday of December, three of whom 8 shall be elected for three years each after the passage of this 9 act.'

Sect. 3. This act shall not take effect during the present 2 term of the Chairman of said Board of Aldermen.
