STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of Jesse Bachelder.

Resolved, That there be paid Jesse Bachelder of Union the
2 sum of twenty dollars per month, payable quarterly from
3 the fund appropriated for military pensions, to begin Janu-
4 ary first, nineteen hundred fifteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The said Jesse Bachelder was born in Union, Maine. He was the son of Benjamin Bachelder who served in the Civil war and was honorably discharged. The above named claimant was born foolish. His father has been dead twenty-five years. His mother and brother have taken care of him from that time until now. His mother died last August at the age of eighty-seven years. The sole care of the boy is now placed upon the brother who is a poor man and whose health is considerably impaired. With this aid he will be no charge to the town or state.
